COURSE SYLLABUS

IOSH Safety for Supervisors [2 day] course is designed for people in supervisory and team leader positions in all types of organisations, who need an understanding of health and safety at work. This course is more in depth than the IOSH Working Safely course but more achievable than the Managing Safely Qualification

The aim is to give supervisors / first line managers etc a working knowledge of all aspects of health and safety, with a specific focus on two areas of legislation relevant to their particular workplace.

These two relevant areas of legislation can be varied to make sure that the course provides maximum benefit to the organisation and the course delegates.

Course objectives

At the end of the course delegates will have discussed:

- Completing and assisting others complete risk assessments in the workplace
- health and safety legislation and relevant regulations

- the responsibilities, liabilities and commitment of supervisors
- assist with the design and application of principles of good practice in health and safety
- 2 specific safety areas of relevance to the site – chosen by the delegates
